The 29th UN Climate Change Conference (COP29), held in Baku, Azerbaijan from November 11 to 22, underscored the essential role of clean hydrogen focusing on climate change.

The conference featured the adoption of a "Hydrogen Declaration," spearheaded by the COP29 Presidency, calling for enhanced global collaboration to scale up hydrogen production and deployment.

The declaration emphasized hydrogen's essential role in enabling the transition to a sustainable economy and addressing energy needs while reducing emissions, with the goal of deploying hydrogen technologies at scale by 2030, integrating both renewable and low-carbon hydrogen production.
